How it all began

In late 1990 the then vicar of St Saviour's, Westgate-on-Sea the **Revd Stanley Evans** put forward the idea of forming an Association called The Friends of St Saviour's. The idea was well received and a working committee was set up.

To satisfy the Charity Commissioners it was imperative the Association should be completely separate from the PCC (Parochial Church Council). In the spring of 1991 a constitution had been drawn up and was accepted by the Charity Commissioners and a charity number allocated (1002041).

During the summer of 1991 members were recruited from the church congregation, the parish of Westgate-on-Sea and from nearby towns. They all had one thing in common; they loved St Saviour's Church and wished to see it standing proudly as a witness to God's presence in Westgate for the foreseeable future.

In September 1991, over **30 years ago**, the first Annual General Meeting was held in the then St Saviour's Church Hall in Ethelbert Square which was well attended.

Recently membership has revived with fundraising for projects such as the disabled access, repairs to the bell tower and fundraising continues to grow.

Looking to the future

The Friends have made grants to the PCC of more than **£55,000**. Many of the things for which the Friends make grants are rather mundane - routine work on the garden, the annual checking of the electrical equipment, cleaning of the carpets, etc. The Friends have also contributed towards major works such as the heating, building repairs and restoration. The Friends welcome you to St Saviour's and encourage you to support our latest ventures.

The current incumbent, **Revd Karen Gooding** welcomes you to St Saviour's.

Following discussions with the Westgate Town Council the Revd Karen Gooding has proposed the building of a **Community Hub** connected to St Saviour's Parish Church. The new Hub building will be used by the entire community of Westgate-on-Sea.

Now more than ever, the **Friends of St Saviour's Parish Church** needs your support as we embark on this new adventure.
